The Minnesota Travel Marketing Awards Program is conducted each year to salute outstanding achievements in travel promotion, public relations, and the advertising of Minnesota's many travel destinations and attractions. Winning entries of travel promotions conducted from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009, will be recognized at the 2010 Minnesota Conference on Tourism, to be held January 26-27, 2010, at Cragun's Resort and Conference Center near Brainerd Minnesota.

Enclosed are copies of the nomination forms for both the Competitive and Special Recognition Programs. These are distinct programs with different judging criteria. Please share this information with your community and encourage applications.

**Competitive entries will be judged along with all other applications based on the budget categories. Organizational budgets are requested to allow the judge's insight into potential capabilities. Judges will have the ability to award for Excellence, Merit and/or not select winners in any category.**

Applicants are asked to include, with their applications, two photos of the event, promotional activity, person nominated or shots of a web site with the application for use in the awards presentation and recorded for posterity on the web. Photos should be submitted as an electronic file (jpg) and submitted on a storage device or by e-mail.

Examples of Competitive Categories might include the following:

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5. Describe the effort's creative background and strategy.

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6. Describe the tracking system used to measure results of the project.

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7. Describe the effectiveness and results of the project. (Specifically, how many people came to your community as a result of your promotion?)

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8. Detail the exact budget for the program, and how it breaks out. Figures should total the amount of the exact budget.

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9. What was the CPI (cost per inquiry) for the effort?

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**Please include two (2) copies of the materials (ads, tapes etc.) for the judging process. These materials should be clearly labeled as to what they are and where they appeared. Materials will be returned after the completion of the 2010 Conference on Tourism.**

Note: Each year the number of entries for the Travel Marketing Awards increases, as does the quality of the efforts entered. The creative ideas are usually strong, but the tracking and measurability are not. Program entries that give exact budget figures, specific costs on everything, and cost per inquiry, as closely as it can be calculated will receive additional consideration.

To better understand the importance of the scoring and assist you in filling out the application, a mock judges scoring sheet is incorporated.

Criteria for judging (each answer rates 1-20 points).

1. How effectively do the promotional efforts used match the objectives for this program? \_\_\_\_\_

## **SPECIAL RECOGNITION AWARDS**

The Special Recognition Awards are presented to individuals and organizations in recognition of major and lasting contributions to the promotion of the Minnesota travel product or dedication to and development of the Minnesota travel industry. As such, these awards may or may not be presented annually, but rather are dependent upon the caliber of, and supporting information for, the respective nominee(s).

Whereas the competitive awards are presented for tourism marketing efforts for the previous calendar year, the Special Recognition Awards are based on commitments to the Minnesota tourism and travel industry that represent lasting or potentially long-term effects, or significant national or international exposure of Minnesota.

Applicants are asked to include two photos of the event, promotional activity, person nominated or shots of a web site with the application for use in the awards presentation and recorded for posterity on the web. Photos should be submitted as an electronic file (jpg) and submitted on a storage device or by e-mail.

The Special Recognition Awards fall into several categories:

**Outstanding Individual** - Presented to an individual who has actively worked to advance tourism, conducting statewide programs that enhance, underwrite, and promote the tourism industry in Minnesota. This person may be a volunteer or an employee of a tourism-related or other business. Special consideration will be given to level of achievements, time period of involvement, and overall contributions to the State's image and/or tourism industry.

**Friend of Tourism Award** - Presented to individuals who have made a significant contribution to Minnesota tourism through a project (e.g. MSP Airport enhancements), or sustained initiative (e.g. tourism awareness.)

**My Favorite Minnesota Award** - Presented to a business, community or organization for tie-ins to the My Favorite Minnesota promotion, based on use of consumer-generated information to market a Minnesota destination, as well as links to [exploreminnesota.com](http://exploreminnesota.com)

**Sustainable Tourism**- presented to the person, company, or institution that supports outstanding efforts to sustain, protect and enhance Minnesota's environment while promoting its tourism markets. The recipient must demonstrate a clear connection between their endeavors and tourism and must also demonstrate exceptional performance in areas such as resource conservation, performance efficiency and increased employee and guest awareness of sustainable tourism practices.
